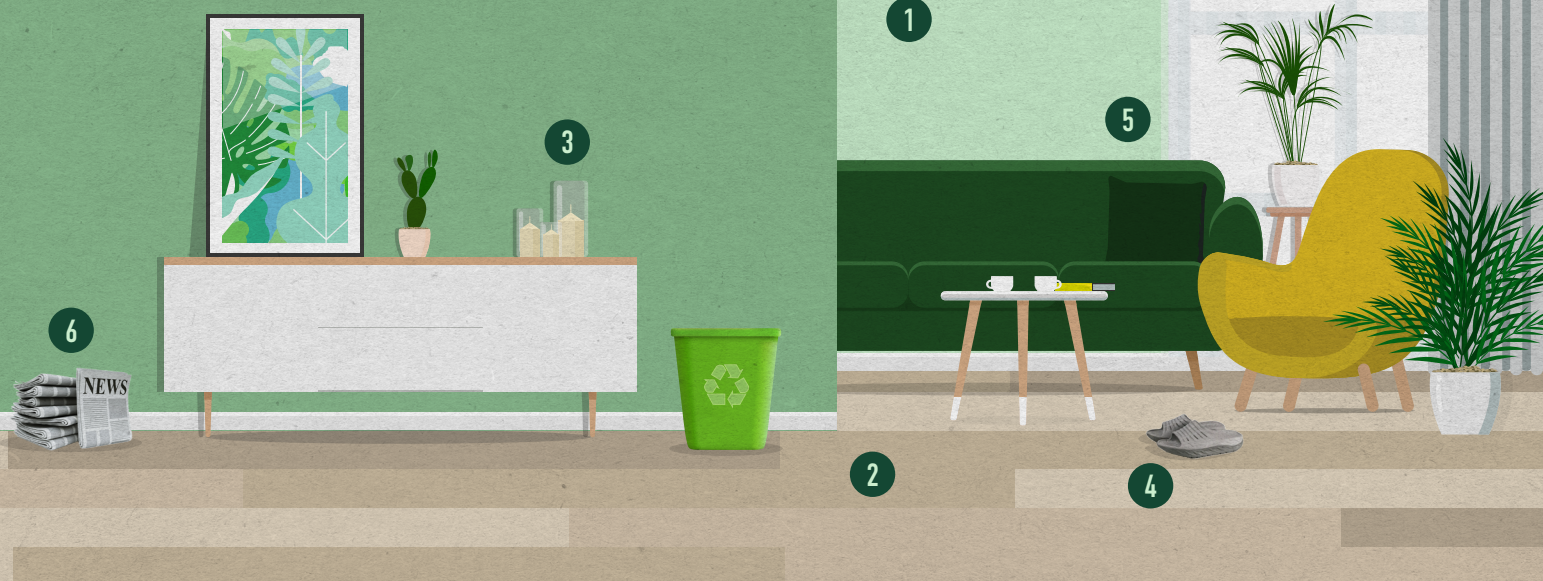


SOY PRODUCTS AT HOME

Soy-based products are found all around the house. See how soy enhances sustainability and performance in everyday products.



1 WALL PAINT – Paint solvents often contain petrochemicals that release volatile organic carbons (VOCs). Soy-based paints offer a sustainable, low-VOC alternative.

2 PLYWOOD – Soy flour is a common ingredient in wood adhesives. It is inexpensive, easy to process, and free of formaldehyde.¹

3 CANDLES – Soy wax has a lower melting point than paraffin wax. This means soy candles have a longer lifetime than paraffin candles.²

4 SANDALS – High-density soy-based foams are durable and offer quick rebound. This material is perfect for footwear with a small environmental footprint.

5 COUCH – Soft furniture uses multiple layers of foam to achieve the perfect balance of comfort and support. Soy-based foams offer flexible formulations to meet these needs.

6 NEWSPAPER – Inks using polymerized soy oil offer sharp images, vivid color, and low rub-off. Soy inks have become a staple of the printing industry.
